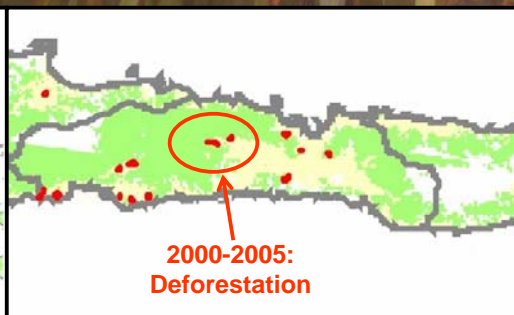

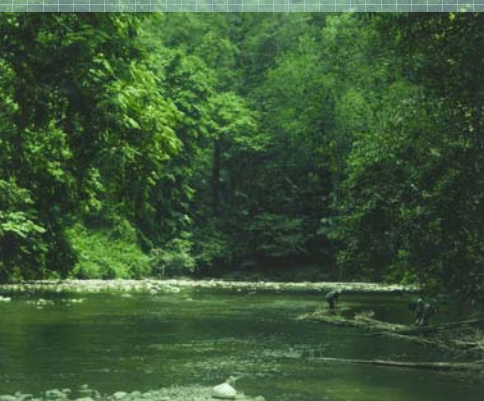
Yayasan Adudu Nantu International (YANI) - Provincial Government Gorontalo

Avoided emissions 0.2\$/t CO₂/year



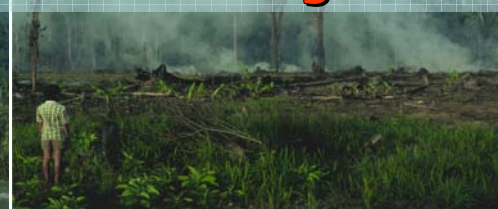
Last stronghold of endangered endemic animals: Babirusa
